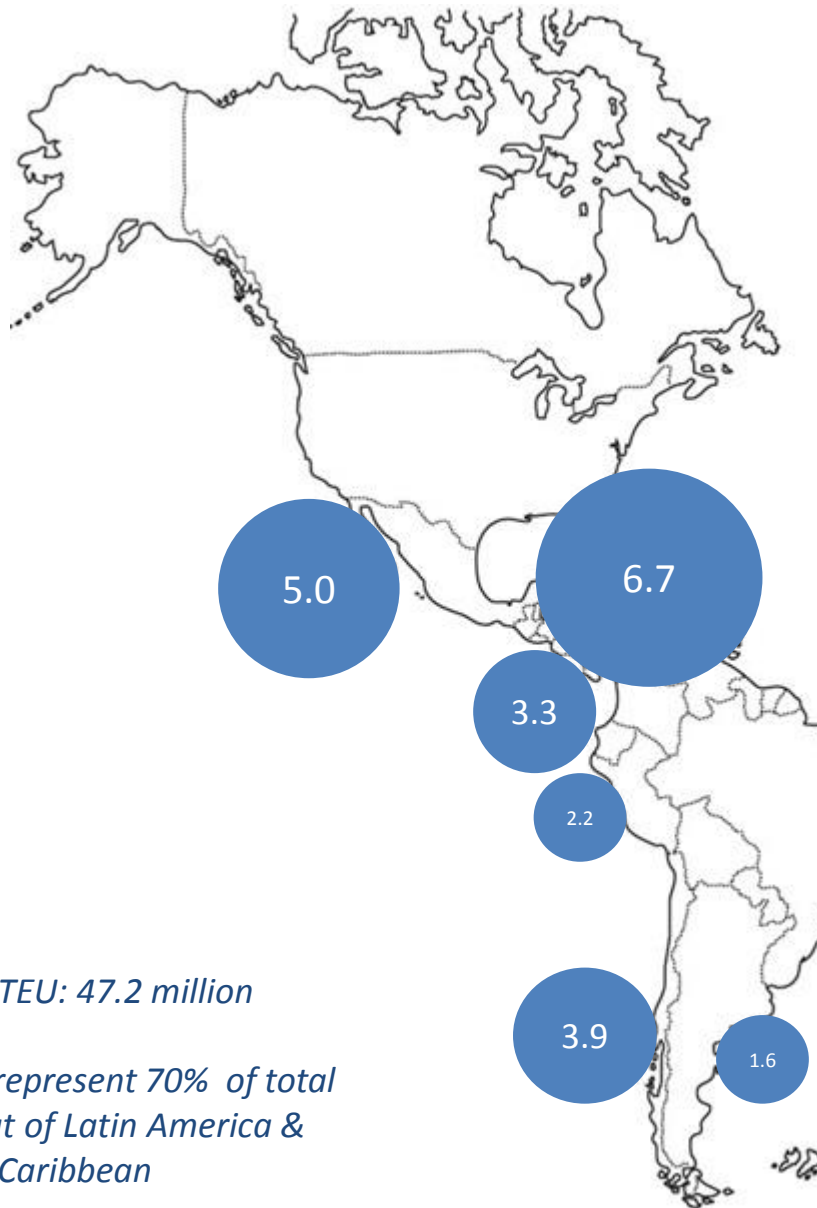

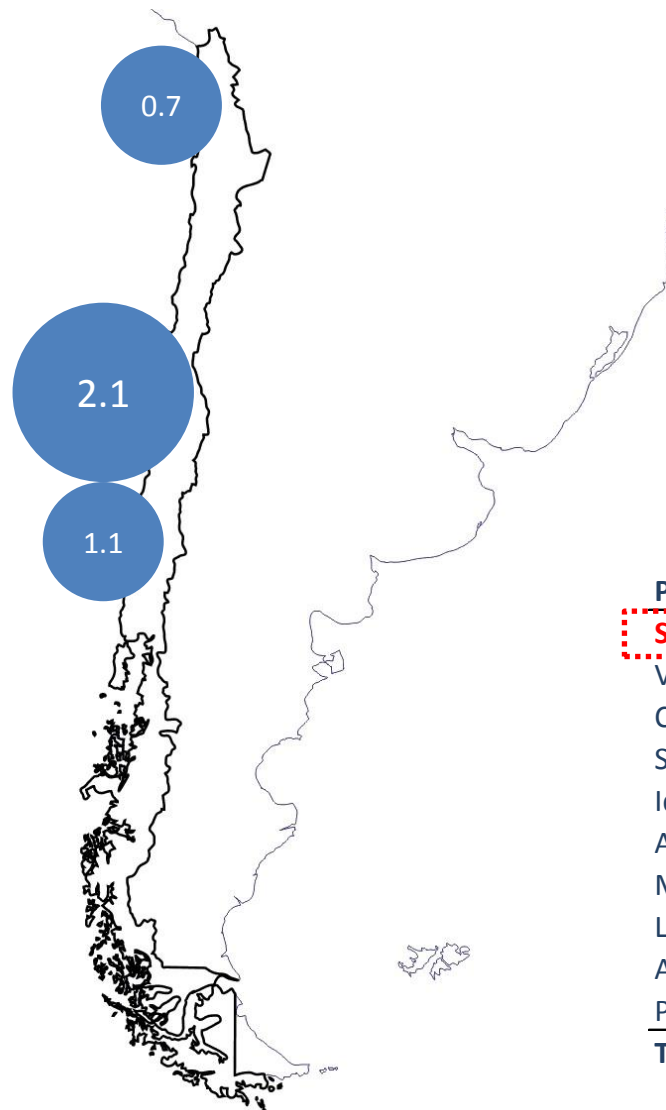
Chile's port terminal ranking 2014
